- Size: Approximately 20' x 25' plus 30' x 30'
- Track Completed: 25%
- Scenery Completed: 15%
- Control: LCC + TCS
- Features: Dual lift bridges for access. Very few under layout supports. Basement excavated for layout expansion.
- Access: The basement layout is normally accessed via two stairway from upstairs, but it may also be accessed from the rear of the house via some rough ground. (walking via a lawn, with no sidewalk, or by driving around on the yard) A bathroom is available on the basement level.
