The railroad depicts the Erie R.R. Delaware Division - 90 miles from Pt. Jervis N.Y. to Binghamton N.Y. It includes multiple bridges over Delaware and Susquehanna rivers, plus the Starucca viaduct, which has 17 arches and is 11 feet long as modeled.
