The layout is a two loop concept with one loop being the former Pittsburgh Northern Railroad that was purchased by the Western Maryland as a satellite operation. The main connection is with the Pennsylvania Railroad at North Pittsburgh Junction. Coal and chemicals are the primary products transported with some remaining passenger service through the PRR connection. We operate both steam and diesel with an emphasis on first generation diesels. All locomotives are smaller with small steam locomotives and B-B diesels.
