

Directions to Southern Piedmont Live Steamers

8283 NC-742 South
Oakboro, NC 28129

From Concord, etc.: From US-29 S/Concord Parkway turn left onto US-601 S. Continue on US-601 S 13.6 miles then turn left onto NC-24/27 E. Go 8.6 miles to Red Cross. There is a traffic light at the intersection of NC-24/27 and NC-205. Turn right toward Oakboro on NC-205, go 4 mi. to Oakboro. At the traffic light, (straight through) take NC-742 south. You will cross the Aberdeen Carolina & Western railroad tracks. About 0.8 mile down NC-742 on the right is where the track (layout) is. The number on the mailbox is 8283. Turn into the drive and you will see us off to the left. If you pass Richard Sandy Road off to the left, you've gone too far.

From Statesville: From NC-115 S take I-77 S to Charlotte, 28.7 miles. Take exit 13 to merge onto I-85 N toward Greensboro. Go 8.8 mi. and exit onto I-485 Inner. Go 10.7 miles and take exit 41 for NC-24/27 east to Red Cross (17.8 mi.). There is a traffic light at the intersection of NC-24/27 and NC-205. Turn right toward Oakboro on NC-205, go 4 mi. to Oakboro. At the traffic light, (straight through) take NC-742 south. You will cross the Aberdeen Carolina & Western railroad tracks. About 0.8 mile down NC-742 on the right is where the track (layout) is. The number on the mailbox is 8283. Turn into the drive and you will see us off to the left. If you pass Richard Sandy Road off to the left, you've gone too far.

Alternate from Statesville: Take US-70 to Salisbury. At the Salisbury Mall/McDonalds turn **right** onto *Jake Alexander Blvd.* Continue about 10 minutes and turn **right** on *US-52/E. Innes Street.* Continue below (From Salisbury).

From Salisbury: From W. Innes St, continue on US-52 S 29.6 miles. Turn right onto NC-27 W and go 1.7 miles. Turn left onto St. Martin Rd. and go 9.9 miles. Continue on E 1st St. 0.4 miles then turn left onto S Main St. Go 0.3 mi. and continue on NC-742 S. You will cross the Aberdeen Carolina & Western railroad tracks. About 0.8 mile down NC-742 on the right is where the track (layout) is. The number on the mailbox is 8283. Turn into the drive and you will see us off to the left. If you pass Richard Sandy Road off to the left, you've gone too far.

From Charlotte: From I-485, take NC-24/27 (Albemarle Road) east to Red Cross (17.8 mi.). There is a traffic light at the intersection of NC-24/27 and NC-205. Turn right toward Oakboro on NC-205, go 4 mi. to Oakboro. At the traffic light, (straight through) take NC-742 south. You will cross the Aberdeen Carolina & Western railroad tracks. About 0.8 mile down NC-742 on the right is where the track (layout) is. The number on the mailbox is 8283. Turn into the drive and you will see us off to the left. If you pass Richard Sandy Road off to the left, you've gone too far.

From South of Charlotte: From I-77N, take exit 1 for Westinghouse Blvd toward James G. Martin Frwy/I-485 /Pineville/Huntersville. Go 0.2 mi. and take exit 1B on the left for I-485 E toward Pineville. Go 1.6 mi. and merge onto I-485 Outer. Go 23.8 mi. and take exit 43 for NC-51 toward Mint Hill. Go 0.4 mi. and turn right onto Blair Rd. Go 1.4 mi. and turn right onto NC-24/27 E/Albemarle Rd. Go 16.5 mi. to Red Cross. There is a traffic light at the intersection of NC-24/27 and NC-205. Turn right toward Oakboro on NC-205, go 4 mi. to Oakboro. At the traffic light, (straight through) take NC-742 south. You will cross the Aberdeen Carolina & Western railroad tracks. About 0.8 mile down NC-742 on the right is where the track (layout) is. The number on the mailbox is 8283. Turn into the drive and you will see us off to the left. If you pass Richard Sandy Road off to the left, you've gone too far.

From West of Charlotte: From I-85N, take I-485 Inner, go 10.7 miles. Take exit 41 for NC-24/27 east to Red Cross (17.8 mi.). There is a traffic light at the intersection of NC-24/27 and NC-205. Turn right toward Oakboro on NC-205, go 4 mi. to Oakboro. At the traffic light, (straight through) take NC-742 south. You will cross the Aberdeen Carolina & Western railroad tracks. About 0.8 mile down NC-742 on the right is where the track (layout) is. The number on the mailbox is 8283. Turn into the drive and you will see us off to the left. If you pass Richard Sandy Road off to the left, you've gone too far.

Both Google Maps and MapQuest will get you there. Hopefully, GPS will also get you there!
